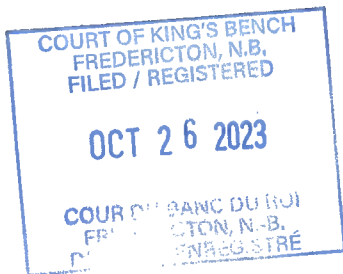

**ORDER**

**WHEREAS** the Applicant filed an Application for Judicial Review and Declaratory Relief on September 6, 2023 (the "**Application for Judicial Review**");

**AND WHEREAS** the Applicant filed a Notice of Motion on September 11, 2023, seeking an Order granting it public interest standing in relation to the Application for Judicial Review (the "**Public Interest Standing Motion**");

**AND WHEREAS** the New Brunswick Teachers' Federation, Egale Canada, Alter Acadie Nouveau-Brunswick Inc., Chroma: Pride, Inclusion, Equality Inc., and Imprint Youth Association Inc. (collectively, the "**Current Proposed Interveners**") have all filed Motions seeking leave to intervene in the Application for Judicial Review;


**AND WHEREAS** it is anticipated that additional groups will be seeking leave to intervene in the Application for Judicial Review;

**AND UPON HEARING** counsel for the Applicant, the Respondent, and the Current Proposed Interveners on October 23, 2023;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. Pending the determination of the Public Interest Standing Motion, the Court has established a deadline for the filing and service of any additional motions seeking leave to intervene in the Application for Judicial Review;
2. Any additional motions seeking leave to intervene in the Application for Judicial Review, along with all supporting motion materials, must be filed with Andrea J. Hull, the Legal Officer of the Court of King's Bench, Judicial District of Fredericton and served by November 30, 2023; and
3. Provided the Court allows the Public Interest Standing Motion, a date will be set for the hearing of all motions for leave to intervene in the Application for Judicial Review.
